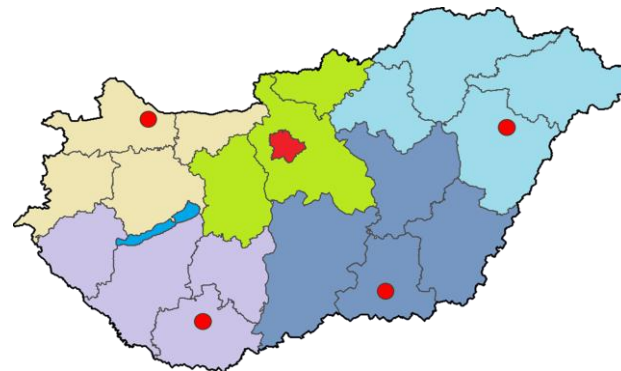
AIMS

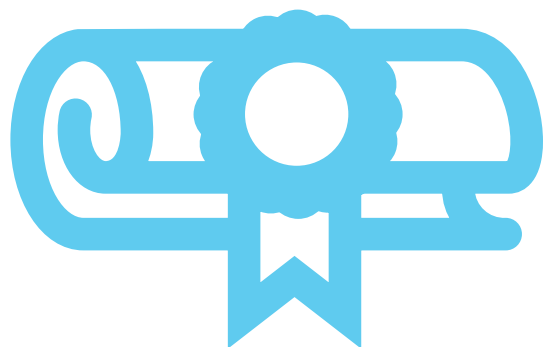
